ARROGANTE SAUVIGNON BLANC 2021

Crushable picnic wine perfect for the turn of the season. Ripe stone fruits with tropical sorbet and green apples.

CORRUPTO CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2021

Ruby red color with aromas of fruity ripe cherries and hints of caramel. On the palate the wine is fresh and juicy with enticing structure and sweet tannins.



• INOCENTE CARMENERE 2021

Fruity nose with notes of pimento and cloves. Since Carmenere is a parent grape of Cabernet Sauvignon, you will see some similarities in the fruit characteristics. However, I feel like the Carmenere if more plush and shows more dark chocolate

• GENEROSO SYRAH 2021

Just like the name would suggest... this wine is GENEROUS! Aromatic blueberries and fresh woodsy tobacco jump out of the glass with a round & blanace palate and an elegant finish.



The Maipo Valley

One of the most well-known regions of Chile for producing wine; the Maipo Valley is located just south of the capital Santiago. Known for producing some of the most renowned red wines of the country, it is often referred to as the Bordeaux of South America. It is said that the Maipo Valley is the heart of winemaking in Chile with the first vines being planted in the 1540s. The climate of this region is Mediterranean; with warm, dry summers and cold, wet winters.

The Laurent Family

Damien Laurent grew up tagging along with his grandfather on their family estate Chateau l'Escart in Bordeaux. Many years later Damien spent about 12 years running the estate with his wife Lorena, who is originally from Chile. In 2008 the couple purchased land in the Maipo Valley and planted about 4 hectares (just under 10 acres) to bordelaise varieties. Damien and Lorena are committed to showcasing delicious unpretentious wines that express the beauty of each variety.
