About "Bloem"

The South African winelands are part of the Cape Floral Kingdom; the smallest but most bio diverse of the world's six floral kingdoms. Bloem is derived from the Dutch word for "flower" and is meant to capture the essence of this unique ecosystem.

Bloem Chenin Blanc & Viognier... 2021

Tasting Notes: The wine shows delicate weight and earthiness, citrus blossom, and stone fruit aromas with a creamy peach palate and crispy finish.

Noble Hill Estate Reserve White... 2021

Tasting Notes: Upon arrival at the winery the grapes are cooled to preserve the fresh flavors and acidity. This wine sits on the lees for 9 months creating a rich weighty texture. This wine is a delicate balance of floral aromas and fresh fruited flavors.

Bloem Syrah & Mourvèdre... 2019

Tasting Notes: Syrah and Mourvèdre are natural partners, having grown together for thousands of years. This blend boasts black currant and cherry fruit aromas, balanced with exotic spice and earthy undertones.

Noble Hill Estate Reserve Red... 2019

Tasting Notes: Each component of this blend carries different varietal characteristics and reflects slight soil differences between each of the vineyards on the estate. It is a true reflection of Simonsberg terroir. The wine elicits the aromas and tastes of fresh plums and herbs.
