

THE BUTCHER'S POUR: NATURAL WINE

Typically grown on a small-scale by sustainable, organic, or biodynamic standards that have nothing added. Some of these wines can show a much funkier palate; which can be a little off-putting. However, there are several winemakers who are taking the time to create natural wines with a more refined palate. Fun, juicy wines that are tasty to drink, and good for the planet.

Charlie & Echo Railfall

100% Riesling

Tasting Notes: Only 24 cases produced. This wine shows underripe yellow apples, lemon peels, and granite with little notes of jasmine.

Chateau Maris Orange... 2021

100% Muscat

Tasting Notes: The juice is dry & succulent. Orange wines are made from white grapes that are allowed to have an extended skin contact like when making red wine. This creates a richer style with small amounts of tannins. That's right! White wine with some tannins. Love these with some fattier fishes, grilled chicken thighs, and pork dishes.

Remhoogte Free To Be Red... 2021

100% Syrah

Tasting Notes: Carbonic style Syrah that creates a wonderfully perfumy aroma of black currents, cloves, and violets. The palate is vibrant with beautiful acidity and supple tannins that have this wine hanging around on the palate. Perfect for BBQ season.

Carbonic- grapes are picked, sorted, and then tossed in the tank whole. Fermentation starts taking place inside each individual grape causing them to burst, and the weight of the grapes crushing those on the bottom. This is the main method of making wines like beaujolais.

Sonder Field Blend... 2021

Blend of Counoise, Grenache, Cinsault, Viognier, Roussanne

Tasting Notes: Aromas of watermelon and strawberry with a hint of raspberry liqueur and spice. Palate is concentrated, driven by floral, strawberry and herbal notes.

Sonder is the realization that everyone lives their own unique and complex life.
