Aichenberg, Grüner Veltliner Premium, 2022

Aichenberg Region Niederösterreich, Austria

This classic Gruner Veltliner shows peppery aromas supported by delicious apricot, lemon and apple flavors mark this Gruner Veltliner. A well-balanced wine with defined varietal character that ends with a mineral note under the fruit driven body. A great pairing with shellfish and seafood, fresh cheeses and spicy dishes.

La Roche Palais, Les Vignes De Rêve Rosé, 2021

Roussillon, France

60% Grenache and 40% Cinsault from the south of France (carrying a Vin de France designation). Pale pink/gold in color, clear and bright. The nose has orange rind and slight strawberries. Nice texture, slightly creamy. On the palate, orange citrus. Medium bodied. Good acidity with a nice, long finish. Pairs well with pasta with fresh summer vegetables.

Rioja Bodegas Riojanas Canchales, 2020

Rioja, Spain

Cherry-red with violet hues, brilliant. Fragrant primary aromas. Fresh, fruity, varietal. Smooth and balanced in the mouth. Slight tannins. Wide, long retronasal sensations with elegant fruity notes. This a juicy and delicious wine that drinks marvelously on its own, but also pairs well with beef, lamb, veal, or poultry dishes.

Château Lamothe Saint Germain, Bordeaux, 2020

Saint Germain Region Bordeaux, France

Well-balanced and appealing blend of 75% merlot and 25% cabernet franc with pure, fresh fruit character and supple texture. One of the best vintages we've tasted from this consistently reliable Bordeaux château. Pair this wine with a delicious steak.
