## **Spanish Wines**

Spanish wine is known for its rich history, diverse varieties, and high quality. The climate and geography of Spain create the perfect conditions for growing a wide range of grapes, resulting in unique and flavorful wines. Additionally, Spanish winemakers have been perfecting their craft for centuries, leading to a strong reputation in the global wine market.

### ***Jean Leon 3055 Chardonnay 2022***

When Jean Leon first arrived in New York, he worked as a taxi driver. 3055 was his license number and represents a look at the man behind the legend. The humble beginnings of an idealist who made his dreams come true, to open the most luxurious restaurant in Hollywood, "La Scala", and to produce his own wine. A bright, fresh and fruity wine for modern palates. It possesses intense tropical fruit notes with a long and lingering finish. Fresh, lingering and elegant on the palate, with a long and balanced finish. Pair with grilled vegetables, rice, and fish.

### ***Jean Leon 3055 Rose 2023***

A sensual rosé with a distinctive pale pink color, made with the Pinot Noir variety, one of the most elegant and international French grapes. With a unique pale pink color, this rosé is characterized by its immense freshness and elegance. The nose is dominated by pronounced notes of strawberry, peach and white cherry, as well as hints of citrus flowers. The palate is remarkably fresh with a balanced acidity and a lingering finish. Pairs perfectly with traditional Spanish appetizers like tapas and charcuterie, as well as with certain vegetable and pasta dishes, medium-aged cheeses, roasts and white meat.

### ***Jean Leon 3055 Red Blend 2022***

This 2022 vintage was awarded Silver from the International Wine Challenge. Floral and red fruit in a juicy style with a herbal note and an inky finish. Lovely fruit intensity here. Black plum, vanilla, subtle spice. Good richness of fruit and firm dry tannins. Pair with lamb.

### ***Vizar Tempranillo 2019***

The 2019 Bodegas Vizar Tempranillo is a cherry color, clean and bright. The aromas are open and intense with notes of red berries (raspberry and blackberry) with touches of pink pepper. Good volume, silky tannins, and a very pleasant balance. An attractive and persistent young wine. Pair with beef, lamb, veal, and poultry.
