Cafe de Paris Brut Blanc

Café de Paris is the only alcoholic brand allowed to carry the word "Paris" in its name. The winery was created by Jacques Cousteau's uncle in the late 1800s in Cubzac-les-Ponts on the limestone banks of the Dordogne River between Bordeaux and Libourne. Winemaker Bruno Kessler uses the Charmat method and extensive Batonnage. This “French touch” adds an elegant finish and creates very fine bubbles. Presents with bright citrus notes like lemon and grapefruit, floral aromas, and a crisp, refreshing palate with fine bubbles; pair it with seafood dishes like oysters, ceviche, or grilled fish, light pasta with white sauce, or even a fruit-based dessert due to its lively acidity and delicate character.

Stel + Mar Sauvignon Blanc

For those cold, dark January days, meet the savvy Sauvignon Blanc—more than just wine, it's your ticket to a tropical oasis. Crisp, vibrant, and bursting with a citrusy ensemble of grapefruit, pineapple, and passion fruit, this is your go-to for an instant summer vibe. Ideal for sunny picnics, beach lounging, or simply unwinding with friends, it's a refreshing escape that celebrates the spirited zest of life. Pair with goat cheese for a girl dinner or serve with a green Thai curry.

Anko Malbec 2022

100% Malbec Vineyard Altitude 5,700 feet Sustainably Farmed & Harvested by Hand 6 months in French oak barrels. Anko means “high water” in the native Indian language of Salta, located in the northwest corner of Argentina. The estate vineyards in Estancia Los Cardones, named for the area's majestic cacti which can grow as tall as 30 feet, are indeed an oasis amid the surrounding jagged landscape. Dark garnet purple color, rich aromas and flavors of dark chocolate, coffee, and berry compote with a silky, fruity yet dry medium to full body with a long vanilla accented finish. Pair with beef and lamb.

Boplaas The Fledge & Co. Souzao 2023

Rare, hard-to-find South African red wine made from Souzao, a Portuguese grape that's usually blended for Port. Fledge & Co. Souzao is light-to-medium-bodied with juicy acidity and hints of gunpowder, raspberry, and cherry. Only 900 bottles were produced, we got the last bottles on the East Coast. Pair with mushrooms, lamb, and beef.
